MASH	Multi-Agency Safeguarding Hub. A partnership between Children's social care, education, youth services, NHS, police & probation working together to safeguard children.			
NFA	No Further Action. If there is not enough evidence the police or CPS may decide not to charge and no further action will be taken.			
HCDV	National Centre for Domestic Violence			
NPCC	National Police Chiefs' Council (guidance for sexual abuse cases)			
Op Encompass	Operation Encompass is a police and education safeguarding partnership enabling schools to offer immediate support to children experiencing domestic abuse.			
OPVA	Older Person's Violence Advisor			
PNC	Police National Computer: The PNC is used to carry out real-time checks, for example on a person's criminal record			
PPO	Police Protection Order. In an emergency situation children can be placed under police protection for up to 72 hours.			
PR	Parental Responsibility			
SARC	Sexual Assault Referral Centre: A confidential medical and practical support service for people who have recently been raped or sexually assaulted.			
SHPO	Sexual Harm Prevention Order: A SHPO is an order that can be issued to a person who has been convicted of an offence listed in either Schedule 3 or Schedule 5 of the Sexual Offences Act 2003.			
SOA	Sexual Offences Act 20			
SOPO	Sexual Offences Prevention Order: Police can apply to the courts for a civil order if they can show that someone poses a threat of serious sexual harm)			
SOR	Sex Offenders Register			
SPO	Stalking Protection Order: An SPO is a civil order, made on application to the magistrate's court by the police. Applications for Interim or full orders can be made where the threshold to commence criminal proceedings for the commission of an offence has not yet or will not be met			
SVSH	Sexual Violence & Sexual Harassment			
VAWG	Violence Against Women and Girls			
VPS	Victim Personal Statement: Allows victims to write a new statement to explain how the crime has affected them, physically, emotionally, financially or in any other way	Get in Touch
